

AXLE WEIGHTS AT GRAINCORP

To all Customers and Truck Companies that load and unload at GrainCorp:

From time to time, truck drivers request that GrainCorp weighbridge operators verbally advise the weight of individual axle groups.

Effective immediately, GrainCorp staff will not communicate weights of individual axle groups to truck drivers because GrainCorp is not able to guarantee the accuracy of these weights and, due to axle weight complexity, provide guidance about what they should be.

For sites with external weighbridge indicators, GrainCorp will not take steps to remove these indicators, but drivers should be aware that when measuring axle weights, the information shown may be inaccurate and should not be relied upon.

GrainCorp will continue to validate the total gross weight of trucks against the identified legal mass limit.
